One of the most immediate differences between Columbus Humanities and almost every school in the area is that we have very high expectations for behavior for our students. Because we are such a uniquely diverse group of students and staff, we take harassment very seriously in order to support a highly engaging and effective academic program.

Since June 2021 to December 2021, we have had sixteen documented cases of harassment. In each instance, the students have received counseling on the issue of harassment through our restorative justice practices, as well as suspensions in alignment with school policies. To date, all students involved in these instances have not had any further issues involving harassing other students or staff.

In each instance, the students have received counseling on the issue of bullying through our restorative justice practices, as well as suspensions in alignment with school policies.
